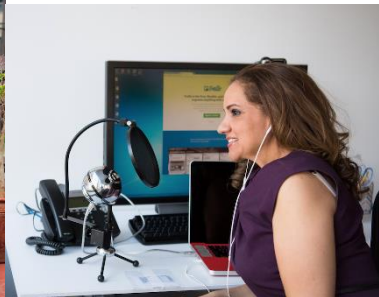

***Baggage** ... the feelings you have about your past and the things that have happened to you, which often have a negative effect on your behaviours and attitudes.*
